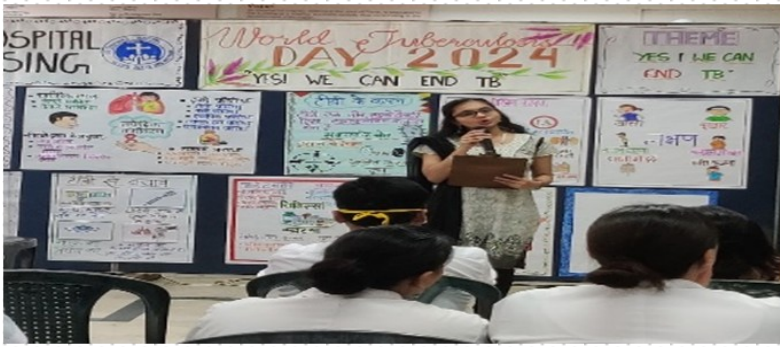
ROLE PLAY ON THE OCCASION OF “WORLD TUBERCULOSIS DAY”

ROLE PLAY ON THE OCCASION OF WORLD MALARIA DAY AT IHBAS

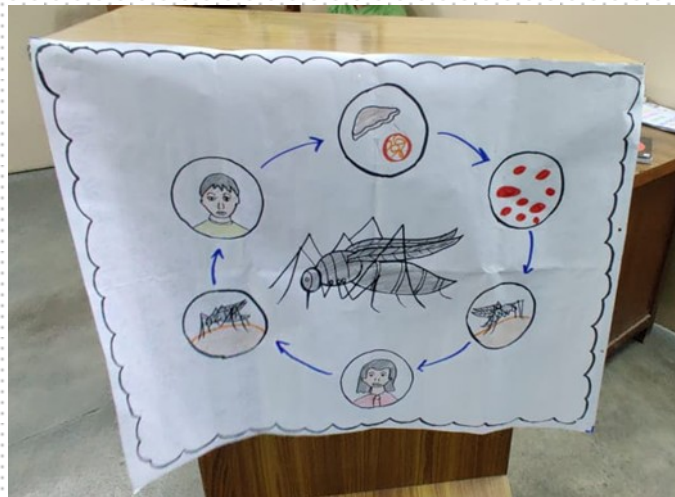

ROLE PLAY ON THE OCCASION OF WORLD MALARIA DAY

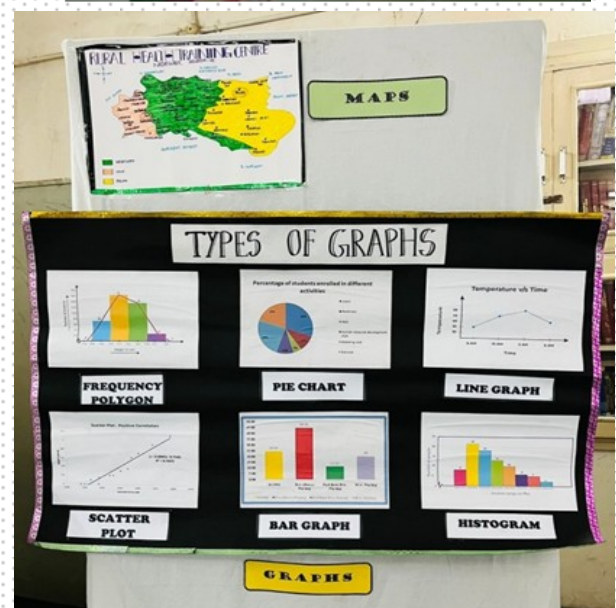
