# ELIGIBILITY

- **Marital Status, Gender, Age and Physique**

Candidates seeking admission to the General Nursing and Midwifery Course must be

- (a) Unmarried
- (b) Female
- (c) Not less than 17 years as on 31<sup>st</sup> December 2026 and below 25 years of age as on 31<sup>st</sup> July 2026
- (d) Medically fit as per the medical examination conducted by St. Stephen's Hospital as part of the admission process.

- **Minimum Education (4.2.1 or 4.2.2)**

10+2 or its equivalent, passed with 50% marks in aggregate, preferably with science subjects. Any three subjects excluding English from the list given below will be considered for admission. Students must have passed in all the subjects of 10+2 (five subjects as per C.B.S.E policy). Passing in English is mandatory.
