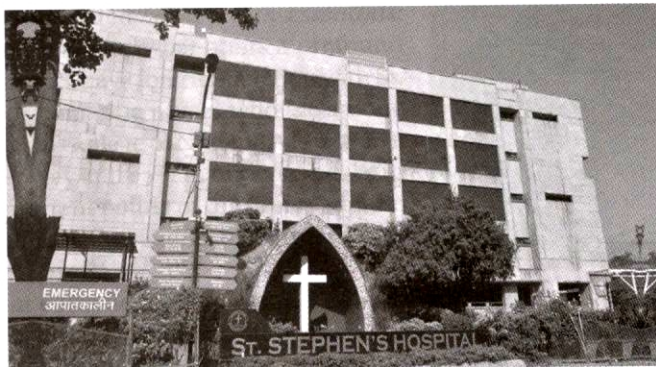

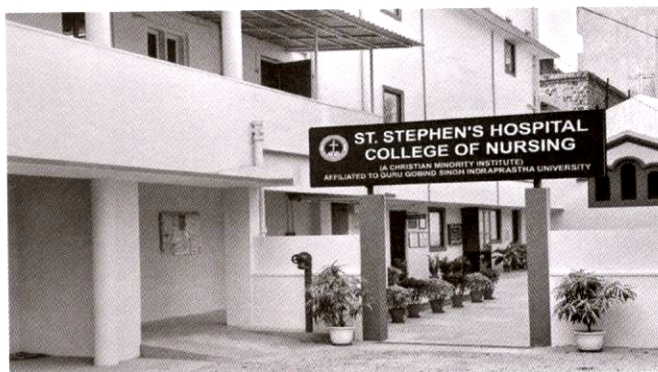

ABOUT THE INSTITUTION

St. Stephen's Hospital, Delhi was established in the year 1885 and is one of the oldest hospitals in Delhi. We have reservation of seats for Christian candidates in our courses as per our status as Christian Minority educational institution. St. Stephen's Hospital College of Nursing is ranked no. 1 by the Indian Institutional Ranking Framework (IIRF) in North India and no. 2 at the National level. St. Stephen's Hospital College of Nursing has received 'Best Nursing College of the Year Award 2025' from the Academic Insights Magazine.
